## What you would do

### Finance graduates:

- Analyse, interpret and report on financial data.
- Prepare budgetary and other reports for resourcing and capital works programs, compliance, funding submissions and business cases.
- Draft policies, implement new processes and monitor compliance.

### Economics graduates:

- Review and analyse the potential effects of existing and proposed policy and prepare economic evaluations and feasibility reports.

### Accounting graduates:

- Prepare financial and management accounting reports.
- Provide input for NSW Treasury Budgetary process and balance and reconcile internal budgets and prepare papers for the RTA's Finance Strategy Committee.
