## Where you could work

You work with subject matter experts from within and external to the RTA, including the NSW Centre for Road Safety, Network Management, Major Infrastructure, Regional Operations and Licensing, Registration and Freight. Working collaboratively in a team based environment, you learn how the RTA is applying technology and regulation to underpin innovative policy initiatives to deliver economic, environmental and safety outcomes for the community.

Our Policy Graduates also contribute to the effective management of the organisation such as Human Resource Strategy, Corporate Planning and Performance, Occupational Health and Safety, and Business Strategy.
