UPGRADE WORKS FOR OCTOBER – DECEMBER 2007

Day and night work

Dear householder,

The Sydney Harbour Bridge is regularly undergoing improvement, maintenance and further upgrading to ensure its longevity. A major program of works has been scheduled with completion planned for early 2009.

This program of works will be delivered by Bridgeworks Alliance, a team consisting of the Roads and Traffic Authority, Boulderstone Hornibrook, Connell Wagner and Austress Freyssinet.

Between October and December 2007, materials will be delivered by barges to the underdeck of the bridge, weather permitting. These deliveries will largely occur Sundays to Thursdays between 10pm and 2am.

Materials will also be delivered by road onto the bridge. These deliveries will largely occur Sunday to Friday from 9.30pm to 7am. You may also notice materials being loaded and unloaded from cranes from time to time.

There may be some noise associated with the use of equipment and reversing beepers from trucks and setting up temporary work platforms.

In addition, some of the 'up-lights' on the bridge will be temporarily removed and/or turned off during these works.

BridgeWorks Alliance will ensure that all noise at night is kept to a minimum. Lighting will be used at night but will be directed away from nearby residences.

While this work may cause some inconvenience, this is essential work that must be done for the sake of this great national treasure. Thank you for your patience.
