Invitation to attend Bourke Street Vision Workshop

In June 2006, the NSW Government announced plans to re-open Bourke Street at William Street. The street has now been re-opened to left-in/left-out traffic access in Bourke Street on the southern side of William Street. The partial closure of Bourke Street (northbound only) north of William Street will remain.

The Government has also proposed to develop a "Vision for Bourke Street" that will provide urban design and traffic management strategies to address the environmental quality of this local street.

The RTA plans to conduct a series of community workshops aimed at producing an urban design strategy and plan for Bourke Street in consultation with community and local interest groups, the City of Sydney and government stakeholders.

Interested members of the community are invited to attend the workshops.

The initial workshop is set for Wednesday 26 July 2006 from 6pm to 9pm at the Mary McDonald Activity Centre, Charles Street, Woolloomooloo.
