
Cowpasture Road upgrade

Hoxton Park Road to Camden Valley Way

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) proposes to upgrade Cowpasture Road from Hoxton Park Road to Camden Valley Way to a four-lane divided road.

Background

Cowpasture Road links The Horsley Drive at Wetherill Park to Camden Valley Way at Leppington. It links new residential areas and employment zones, provides a regional freight link between Prestons, Wetherill Park and Smithfield industrial estates and will provide an important link to the Westlink M7 (Western Sydney Orbital).

The upgrade will provide improved access and a safer road environment for all road users.

Cyclists and pedestrians will benefit from new pedestrian and cycle paths with connections to local bicycle networks through the regional park, including the 39km cycleway to be constructed along the Westlink M7.

Hoxton Park Road to Latrobe Road

Major work will start in mid 2004 on the section between Hoxton Park Road and Latrobe Road, including the intersection of Cowpasture Road, Mannow Avenue and Tibooburra Road.

Nineteenth Avenue will be closed at Cowpasture Road to improve safety for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists. Access to Cowpasture Road will be via the new signalised intersection at Tibooburra Road.

Features

- Cowpasture Road widened to a four-lane divided road with a central median strip from Hoxton Park to Mannow Avenue and Tibooburra Road.
- Improved intersection with traffic signals and pedestrian crossings at Mannow Avenue and Tibooburra Road.

- Turning lanes providing safer access for local communities.
- Shared pedestrian/cyclist paths on both sides of Cowpasture Road.
- Landscaping to complement the local environment.

Benefits

- Improved safety for local and through traffic.
- Improved safety for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Improved access to Cowpasture Road.
- Improved safety at intersections.

Latrobe Road to Camden Valley Way

The RTA is finalising the concept design for the section of Cowpasture Road from Latrobe Road to Camden Valley Way. The concept design for this section is included on the map attached to this update and the display locations listed.

During construction

Work will be carried out on weekdays from 7am to 6pm and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

Affected local residents will be notified in advance of any work outside these hours.

Areas near work sites will be speed limited to 40km per hour.

Community Liaison

The RTA will hold meetings with Liverpool City Council, local residents and local businesses to provide updates on the work and to clarify any arising issues. A community liaison group will be formed to exchange information during construction.
