Additional Traffic Data Collected</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coolaroo Road</li> <li>• Beaconsfield Road</li> <li>• Elizabeth Parade</li> <li>• Howarth Road</li> <li>• Sera Street</li> <li>• Kimberley Avenue</li> </ul> <p>Average weekday daily (24hr) volumes are shown on the attached plan.</p> <p><b>3. Finalisation of LATM Schemes for Public Exhibition</b></p> <p><b>1. Mowbray Road Precinct</b></p> <p>a) Three options to go out to the community.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Leave Mowbray Road “as is”. (subject to comments b &amp; c below)</li> <li>2. Mark edge lines and install kerb blisters.</li> <li>3. Mark edge lines and install central pedestrian refuges.</li> </ol> <p>b) Install traffic lights at Ralston Avenue as agreed by both Councils (three proposals).</p> <p>c) Investigate right turn arrow from Mowbray Road eastbound into Centennial Ave.</p> <p>Comments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The majority of the CAG members did not support devices down the centre of Mowbray Rd West. It was reiterated that traffic lights at Felton Avenue were requested for pedestrian safety.</li> <li>• Arup should prepare a scheme similar to that proposed to Centennial Avenue and present both options to the community.</li> </ul> <p>Responses to previous comments:</p> <p><i>Residents and Council would like to keep configuration of Epping Rd during ramp-up period in order to protect Mowbray Rd from additional traffic intrusion.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is outside the LATM scope, but will be raised with the relevant RTA personnel.</li> </ul> <p><i>Many members of the CAG do not believe the modelling predictions of a traffic decrease on Mowbray Rd.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Arup is not able substantiate the modelling undertaken as part of the EIS process.</li> </ul> <p><i>Consider a potential right-turn from Mowbray Rd westbound into Greenlands Rd.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There is not adequate land available for both dedicated left and right turn lanes.</li> </ul> <p><i>Maintain two eastbound lanes on Mowbray Rd, east of the Ralston traffic signals.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This has been incorporated into the scheme, as circulated with the previous minutes.</li> </ul>			

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<p><b>4. Outline of the Public Exhibition Process</b>            Separate brochures for the 4 areas will be prepared with draft schemes. Display panels will be placed in Council offices. One out-of-hours venue will be arranged for each council area. Internet information to be available. There will be a 4 to 6 week exhibition period.</p> <p>Process outline prepared by the RTA is attached.</p>
