TELEGRAPH POINT COMMUNITY MEETING PACIFIC HIGHWAY UPGRADE

Members of the local community are being asked to comment on access arrangements in the Telegraph Point area for the Pacific Highway upgrade between Oxley Highway and Kempsey.

An RTA spokesperson said feedback from the community meeting will assist in the development of the concept design and environmental assessment.

“The RTA encourages community members to attend the information session on Thursday, 19 July at Telegraph Point,” the spokesperson said.

“A meeting is being held to provide an update on the proposed access arrangements and interchange locations in the Telegraph Point area.

“The meeting will provide community members with the opportunity to discuss the proposals with the project team.

“The design of the preferred route for the Oxley Highway to Kempsey upgrade will be refined once feedback from the community is received as well as the results from further survey, geotechnical and ecological investigations,” they said.
