Brunswick Heads to Yelgun Traffic Switch Picture Opportunity

Traffic will switch to the newly completed Brunswick Heads to Yelgun upgrade of the Pacific Highway tomorrow morning.

At 7.30am on Wednesday cars will be diverted onto the northbound carriageway of the \$256 million upgrade for the first time.

The RTA will remove traffic barriers at the southern end of the upgrade.

Traffic will switch onto the southbound carriageway at the northern end of the upgrade later in the day.
