Dear resident/business operator,

The Sydney Harbour Bridge is regularly undergoing improvement, maintenance and further upgrading to ensure its longevity. A major program of works has been scheduled with completion planned for mid 2009.

This program of works will be delivered by BridgeWorks Alliance, a team consisting of the Roads and Traffic Authority, Baulderstone Hornibrook, Connell Wagner and Austress Freyssinet.

As part of these works a new water main connection is to be installed at Alfred Street South.

This work will occur for up to four weeks commencing on **Monday 30 June 2008**, Normal working hours will be Monday to Friday 7am to 5pm.

As part of these works a small enclosed temporary work site compound will be established on the western side of Bradfield Park immediately adjacent to the car parking spaces in Alfred Street.


There will be temporary traffic control measures in place and impacts on up to six car parking spaces on the eastern side of Alfred Street. An alternate temporary pedestrian footway will be provided.

Noise from road excavation equipment and truck reversing beepers can be expected at times.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused by these essential works. Sydney Water will notify residents directly should there be any disruption to the water supply as a result of these works.
