SYDNEY HARBOUR MARITIME EXCLUSION ZONE

Dear mariner,

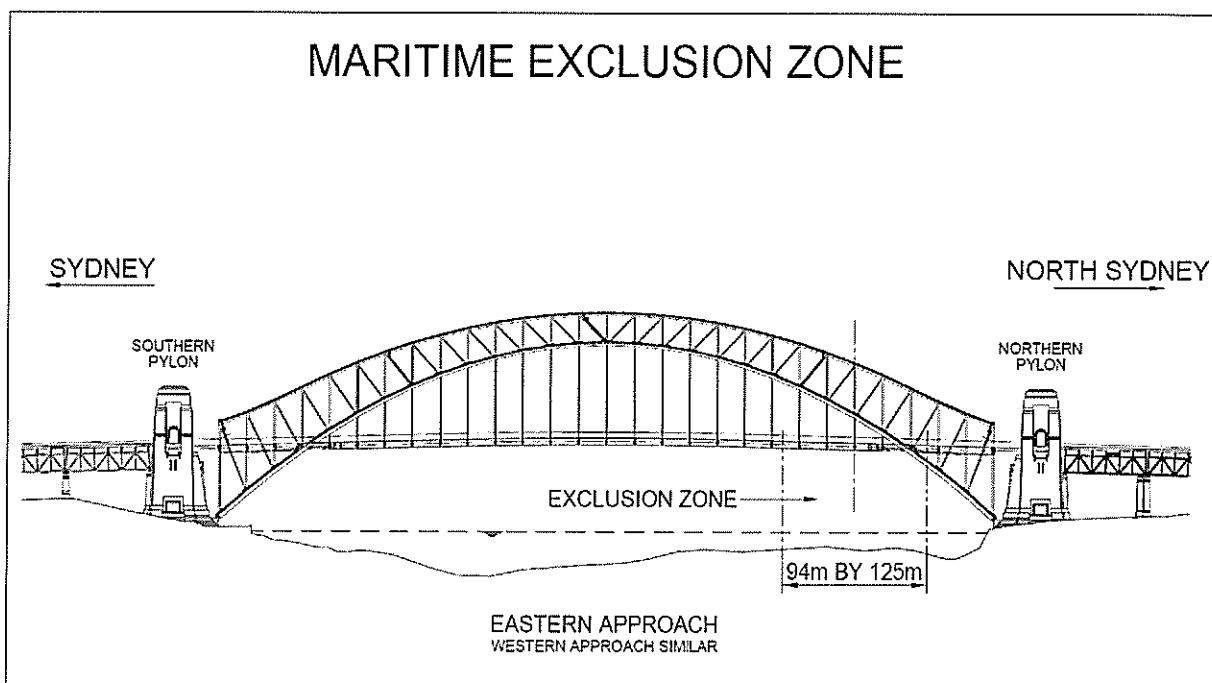
The Sydney Harbour Bridge is regularly undergoing improvement, maintenance and further upgrading to ensure its longevity. A major program of work is underway which the RTA plans to complete by early 2010.

This program of works is being delivered by BridgeWorks Alliance, a team consisting of the Roads and Traffic Authority, Baulderstone, Connell Wagner and Austress Freyssinet.

A maritime exclusion zone will operate under the Sydney Harbour Bridge from 10am Monday 30 March to midnight Thursday 2 April 2009.

The exclusion zone will be indicated by marker buoys and lights. The zone is 94 metres wide and 125 metres long and is located towards the northern shoreline (see diagram below).

If the scheduled exclusion zone cannot go ahead due to poor weather, this activity will be programmed to occur the following week, commencing on Monday 6 April 2009, or alternatively the week commencing Monday 20 April 2009.



NAVIGATION RESTRICTION – SYDNEY HARBOUR SYDNEY HARBOUR BRIDGE MAINTENANCE WORKS

Mariners are advised that NSW Maritime has issued an Exclusive Use Aquatic Licence to the BridgeWorks Alliance to carry out essential maintenance work on the underdeck of the Sydney Harbour Bridge from the dates above.

This maintenance work will involve static barge operations towards the northern shoreline. An exclusion zone of approximately 100 metres in width and 120 metres in length will be in force around the barge.

A series of marker buoys and lights will be used to identify the exclusion zone. Boat operators are requested to stay well clear of the marker buoys.
