ROAD EXCAVATION WORKS

Night works

Dear householder,

The Sydney Harbour Bridge is regularly undergoing improvement, maintenance and further upgrading to ensure its longevity. A major program of works has been scheduled with completion planned for late 2009.

This program of works is being delivered by BridgeWorks Alliance, a team consisting of the Roads and Traffic Authority, Baulderstone Hornibrook, Connell Wagner and Austress Freyssinet.

As part of this work, essential road excavation work is required. Part of the road surface will be excavated in order to make improvements to the bridge's drainage system.

This work will occur for up to five days, starting on **Sunday 23 November 2008**. This work will be carried out at both the northern and southern ends of the bridge.

Working hours will be 9pm to 5am. We are not able to do this work during the day as it requires the closure of lanes 6, 7 and 8. These lane closures will happen at night to keep traffic impacts to a minimum.

There will be some noise from the use of road excavation equipment and reversing beepers from trucks. Measures will be used to limit the noise created by reversing beepers and to limit vibrations created by the excavation equipment. We will be conducting regular noise monitoring to ensure noise levels are kept to a minimum.

Lighting will be used for this work but will be directed away from nearby residences.
