	<p data-bbox="662 913 1254 945"><u>Additional vehicle and operating requirements:</u></p> <p data-bbox="662 952 1407 1093">Conditional registration of Argos for aquatic weed spraying operations is only available where the vehicle meets the following general conditions and operates in the following circumstances:</p> <ul data-bbox="673 1099 1407 2018" style="list-style-type: none"> <li data-bbox="673 1099 1407 1205">• Will be used mostly off-road and away from road-related areas, but needs limited access to the road network <li data-bbox="673 1211 1407 1272">• The Argo must be approved for such operations by its manufacturer <li data-bbox="673 1279 1407 1420">• The spray tank must be compatible with the Argo and not destabilise it under specified operating conditions; this applies regardless of the percentage the spray tank is filled to <li data-bbox="673 1426 1407 1532">• When full, the combined weight of the spray tank and the operator must not exceed the Argo's maximum load limit specified by the manufacturer <li data-bbox="673 1538 1407 1680">• The Argo configured with the spray tank and ancillary equipment must not be operated on slopes that exceed the manufacturer's specifications for such operations <li data-bbox="673 1686 1407 1747">• The Argo operator must undertake accredited training in operating the Argo <li data-bbox="673 1753 1407 1933">• The applicable local council or weed control authority, golf club, other private property owner, state or federal agency must provide a letter confirming that they are responsible for ensuring that all the above conditions are met at all times <li data-bbox="673 1939 1407 2018">• If operating in national parks, restricted to specific areas of operation approved by the NSW National Parks and 	

Wildlife Service

- All lighting must be fitted as near as possible to the position specified in Schedule 2 of the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007*.

Driver Licence type required:

Class C

Mandatory conditions:

- Daylight / floodlit worksite use only.
- Restricted to a maximum speed of 30km/h.
- Not to exceed manufacturer's seating capacity.
- Flashing amber beacon required and used when vehicle moving.
- Vehicle to be floated from site to site (except that it can operate in areas designated below).
- Restricted to designated areas/routes as per contracted work site.
- Must not be used within 3 metres of the sealed/formed road, except for the purpose of crossing a road, loading or unloading.
- If hydraulic steering fitted, steering failure warning device/sign required.
