<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clearance lights required on trailers 1.8 metres or more wide. • Each unit is to be individually registered. • WorkCover Certificate of plant item registration for the trailer unit. • Approval from the management of the intended area of operation (eg Darling Harbour). • Operator needs to contact Transport NSW if vehicles operated for 'hire or reward'. • Customer needs to contact WorkCover Authority for specific requirements for plant and amusement vehicles. • All lighting must be fitted as near as possible to the position specified in Schedule 2 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007.
