	<p><u>Additional vehicle requirements:</u></p> <p style="color: red;">Only blast cleaners, such as that pictured above, intended for use in car parks, parks, on footpaths etc, are eligible for conditional registration. For conditional registration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Vehicle must not to be operated on a road but can cross a road by the most direct route and can be operated on a road related area (ie a footpath, car park,etc) • If used in line marking operations, the vehicle can be used on a road provided it is closed to other traffic. • All lighting must be fitted as near as possible to the position specified in Schedule 2 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007. • Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG) capable vehicles must display the red LPG sticker on the front and rear number plates. • Operators must be properly restrained with at least a lap seatbelt. <p><u>Driver Licence type required:</u> Class C</p> <p><u>Mandatory conditions:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Daylight/floodlit use only • Flashing amber beacon required and used when vehicle moving. • "Slow Vehicle" sign required • Vehicle to be floated from site to site (except that it can travel in areas designated below). • Use only within a defined area where a traffic control 	

plan applies.

Additional condition for vehicles with hydraulic steering:

- Steering failure warning device/sign required.
