

	<p><u>Additional vehicle requirements:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only non-complying motorcycles and 'quad bike' type all-terrain vehicles, such as those illustrated, may be registered for recreation use on the Stockton Beach Recreation Vehicle Area. For use of ATVs by surf life-saving clubs on other beaches see All-terrain vehicles. • All conditionally-registered recreational vehicles must be declared roadworthy by an AIS report or a Customer Roadworthiness Declaration. • All lighting must be fitted as near as possible to the position specified in Schedule 2 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007. <p><u>Driver licence type required:</u> A driver or rider of a motor vehicle in the Stockton Beach Recreational Vehicle Area (RVA) does not require a driver or rider licence. The driver or rider cannot be less than eight years of age.</p> <p><u>Mandatory conditions:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Daylight / floodlit worksite use only. • Vehicle to be floated from site to site. • Restricted to a maximum speed of 40km/h or the manufacturer's recommended speed, whichever is less. • Recreation vehicle restricted to designated area of Stockton beach.
