## Changes to the validity period of light vehicle 'pink slips' and e-Safety Check inspections

### Background

The validity period of light vehicle 'pink slips' and e-Safety Check inspection reports will increase from 28 days to 42 days from the date of issue.

The new validity period is consistent with renewal registration notices, which are sent to customers up to six weeks before registration expiry. Customers will have more flexibility in obtaining their 'pink slips' and paying for their registration at any time during the six-week period.

These changes do not apply to Heavy Vehicle Authorised Inspection Station 'pink slips' and the Authorised Unregistered Vehicle Inspection Station 'blue slips', which are only valid for 28 days from the date of issue.

### Procedure

Authorised examiners are requested to continue to use existing 'pink slip' forms and to manually change the existing 'pink slips' to reflect the new validity period. Revised forms have been ordered and will be distributed as usual through Roads and Traffic Authority motor registries subject to the depletion of existing 'pink slips'. Amended e-Safety Check inspection reports will be available online from 29 August 2005.
