Agricultural harvesters – exemption from brake light requirement

Purpose

To inform vehicle operators that agricultural harvesters are exempt from standard requirements to have brake lights fitted.

Issue

The Roads and Traffic Authority has exempted conditionally registered self-propelled agricultural harvesters from the requirement to fit brake lights. The exemption notice is attached as Attachment 'A'.

This exemption has been granted pursuant to the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007.

Vehicles to which this exemption applies

This exemption applies to conditionally registered self-propelled agricultural harvesters.

Conditions

This exemption is issued subject to the following conditions:

- The vehicles must comply with the conditions to which they are subject as 'conditionally registered vehicles' as set out in the Certificate of Approved Operations.
- It applies solely to the use of the vehicles on road and road related areas.

Duration

This exemption commenced on 1 September 2007 and remains in force until amended or revoked by formal notice.

Agricultural Harvester Exemption Notice



Pursuant to Clause 10, Schedule 2 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007 (the Regulation), the Roads and Traffic Authority does hereby exempt the type of vehicle described in Schedule 1 below from the requirement to fit brake lights as required by Clause 2 (3) of Schedule 2 of the Regulation, subject to the conditions stated in Schedule 2 below.

Schedule 1: Vehicles to which this exemption applies

This exemption applies to conditionally registered self-propelled agricultural harvesters.

Schedule 2: Conditions

This exemption is issued subject to the following conditions:

- The vehicles must comply with the conditions to which they are subject as 'conditionally registered vehicles' as set out in the Certificate of Approved Operations.
- It applies solely to the use of the vehicles on road and road related areas.

Duration

This exemption commenced on 1 September 2007 and remains in force until amended or revoked by formal notice.
