

Q and A's for Pacific Highway bypassed towns signage Competition

Who can put in a submission?

Local residents living in the towns of Kew, Moorland and Johns River and its immediate vicinity.

Kew – postcodes 2439 and 2443

Moorland – postcode 2443

Johns River – postcode 2443

When will the signs be built?

Early in 2011.

How much does it cost to enter?

Entry to the competition is free.

Will the RTA reimburse for the images - what is the copywrite?

No reimbursement will occur – the images have to be donated to the competition.

When are submissions due?

The competition commences on 11th November 2010 and entries close on 10 December 2010 at 5pm.

What about late submissions?

Late entries will not be accepted.

How are submissions to be submitted?

Submit your entry by completing the entry form and sending it, along with your image to: *RTA Pacific Highway office, 21 Prince Street, Grafton, NSW, 2460*. You can find an entry form in the Port Macquarie Express or the Camden Haven Courier.

Does any other information need to be submitted with my image or idea?

All entries must include the proposed image or idea, the individual (s) name and contact details proposing the image or idea and if you like a statement (no longer than 50 words) on the rationale for the proposed image or idea.

What does my image have to represent?

The image or idea should be appropriate to or identify to the community the physical, historical or cultural character of the local area.

Does my image need to be a certain quality?

Yes, your image must be sent in high resolution – 3MB or more.

How will the winner be decided?

A judging panel will decide the winner. The panel includes:

- 2010 Macquarie Hasting Council and Greater Taree City Council local Australian or citizen of the year (2 panel members)
- RTA Urban Design representative – Gareth Collins (1 panel member)
- Editor of the papers – Port Macquarie Express and Camden Haven Courier (2 panel members)
- State Member for Port Macquarie Peter Besling (1 panel member)

How will the winner be notified?

The winning entry will be notified in writing and local papers will identify the winning entry.

Will there be a prize?

There is no cash or material reward prize for the winning entry.
